The Synagogue requires the Rabbi to certify that all new members are Jewish. Almost all Jewish organizations such as burial societies, schools, welfare organizations, require formal proof of Jewish status. They usually turn to the synagogue to ask us to confirm that our members are Jewish, so we have a duty to be clear on this matter. If you have any documents which establish your Jewish status, such as a brit milah (circumcision) certificate; bat or bar mitzvah certificate; ketubah (marriage certificate) your own or your parents'; conversion certificate; or any correspondence from a synagogue of which you were formerly a member, would you please let the Rabbi have a copy with this application form.

Having copies of such evidence of status on your membership file will also serve as a 'back up' for you should documents ever be lost.
